When a child turns 18, parents no longer have a right to obtain medical information on the child without the child's express consent. In addition to a Will, the Financial Power of Attorney and Health Care Power of Attorney and Living Will are equally important, and for single people, perhaps even more so. These two types of Powers of Attorney both involve appointing someone to act as your decision-maker in the event you are unable to do so.

Financial Power of Attorney - This document lets you appoint someone to manage your day-to-day financial and personal affairs if you become unable to do so for yourself.

Health Care Power of Attorney – This document allows you to name an individual or individuals who are authorized to discuss and make decisions on your treatment and care. The Living Will provides doctors and family members with a clear statement of your wishes should you be in a terminal condition or in a state of permanent unconsciousness.

For the same reasons people purchase insurance, every responsible adult should have a Will and Powers of Attorney as part of future planning that gives you and your family peace of mind.
